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## **Notice to Property Taxpayers**

Franklin County Treasurer Ed Leonard announces that property owners can expect to receive their 2013 2<sup>nd</sup> half tax bills in the mail as early as Tuesday, May 20, 2014. Tax amounts for 2013 property taxes can also be viewed and printed by accessing our Property Search Application (<http://treapropsearch.franklincountyohio.gov/>). Payments can be also made paid online now by accessing the Treasurer's Online Payment Application (<http://treasurer.franklincountyohio.gov/payments/online-payments-information>).

Payments may be made in person at the Franklin County Treasurer's Office 373 S. High St., 17<sup>th</sup> Floor from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm through June 20, 2014, in the drop-off box designated for tax payments located in the lobby of the courthouse pavilion entrance at 365 S. High St., or at the central Ohio Heartland Bank branch locations. Heartland Bank accepts checks and money orders for all individuals (including those without accounts), but are not accepting cash payments.

2013 property tax payments may also be made online by e-check or credit card at <http://treasurer.franklincountyohio.gov/payments/online-payments-information>. There is no cost to pay by e-check; however credit card payments are charged a 2.35% convenience fee by the processing company that handles the transaction. Franklin County does not receive any portion of this fee.

By law, second half payments paid after Friday, June 20, 2014 will be assessed a penalty regardless of whether or not the taxpayer received a bill. The Treasurer has no authority to waive penalties.

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
