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Property Taxes Due Next Monday!

(Columbus, OH) 2015 2nd half property taxes are due on Monday, June 20, 2016. Tax bill information, as well as a PDF of current bills, is currently available on our website <http://treasurer.franklincountyohio.gov> to view and print.

To avoid a late charge, the Treasurer encourages people mailing their taxes to get a “Proof of Mailing” from the post office. This will cost \$1.30, but will help to avoid any interest and/or penalties if the office receives the payment after Monday, June 20, 2016.

Payment Options:

On-Line: At <http://Treasurer.franklincountyohio.gov>, real estate tax payments may be made online by credit card or e-check. Please note that online credit card payments will be assessed a 2.35% convenience fee, payments by e-check do not have service fee charges.

In Person: Payments may be made in person at the Franklin County Treasurer’s Office 373 S. High St., 17th Floor from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday-Friday through June 20, 2016, or 24 hours a day in a drop box designated for tax payments located in the lobby of 365 S. High St.

Heartland Bank Locations: Taxpayers may also pay in person at any Heartland Bank location. You do not need to be a customer to make a payment at a Heartland Bank Branch; but please note due to federal regulations cash payments will not be accepted by non-Heartland Bank customers. By law, 2015 second half real estate tax payments paid after June 20, 2016 will be assessed a penalty regardless of whether or not the taxpayer received a bill. The Treasurer has no authority to waive penalties.
